The 18th annual *Palm Beach County KDW Classic* - hosted by the City of Riviera Beach and the West Palm Beach Fishing Club (WPBFC) will take place Saturday, June 5th, at the Riviera Beach Marina. Our goal remains to produce a fun and reasonably priced fishing tournament that stimulates the local marine & fishing industry, helps promote Riviera Beach & Palm Beach County and benefits the marine conservation & educational efforts of the WPBFC and it's charitable affiliate, the Palm Beach County Fishing Foundation (PBCFF). The PBCFF's annual *Kid's Fishing Day* for underprivileged youth and *Rods & Reels for Kids* are two programs that benefit from tournament proceeds. The WPBFC & PBCFF have been tireless advocates on marine conservation and public access issues and actively support marine habitat enhancement.

The first 200 boats to register will receive a fantastic tournament captain's bucket. The Captain's Kick Off Party, in Bicentennial Park at the North end of the Riviera Beach Marina, will feature food, soda, beer, & bar service by Bonner Mobile Bar, a fantastic raffle, music and a review of tournament rules. To start things off with a bang, anglers will have a chance to win before they even wet their lines! A \$1,000 'Captain's Booty' cash award, sponsored by Tow Boat U.S. will be randomly drawn on the night of Captain's Meeting.

The next morning the *Palm Beach County KDW Classic* will begin at 6:30 a.m. Tournament boats can conveniently leave from any inlet of their choice. Anglers will be vying for \$34,000 in guaranteed cash awards. Kingfish, dolphin and wahoo pay out to ten places. Juniors will compete for 10 awards and are eligible for 15 Junior Treasure Chest awards (fifteen \$100 bills)! Additionally, more than \$30,000 worth of merchandise will be presented in the tournament raffle and 'Treasure Chest' giveaways. One lucky boat will "Hit the Jackpot!" and win \$2,000 cash, proving you don't have to be good at catching big fish to win big bucks! Thanks to Ande Monofilament, there is a \$1,000 cash bonus to the angler weighing in the heaviest eligible fish of the tournament. The male and female angler lucky enough to weigh-in the heaviest fish will be crowned the King & Queen of the *Classic* by our presenting sponsor the Marine Industries Association of Palm Beach County. Coveted bragging rights go with this title! We are committed to producing a value-packed, fun, family-oriented event and invite you to become a part of this local sport fishing tradition. Tournament Rules:

1. **WEATHER:** The decision to fish is solely the captain's choice. All anglers fish at their own discretion and risk. If the tournament rules committee determines it is unsafe to fish, all cash awards will still be presented by randomly selecting boat numbers at the awards party (must be present to win). No entry refunds.
2. No visual check out or check in is required. Lines in at 6:30 a.m and lines out at 2:00 p.m. All anglers entering fish must return to Riviera Beach Marina in the boat they fished from and be standing in line at the tournament weigh station by 3:00 p.m. Failure to be in line by this time will disqualify your catch.
3. All state & federal recreational fishing rules governing weight, size, bag limits and licensing must be observed. Only legal sized fish will be weighed.
4. Eastern boundary is 25 nautical miles. Fishing in the Bahamas is prohibited.
5. All fish must be caught on rod and reel (no electric reels). Kites, downriggers, planers, and wire lines are permitted. No line test restrictions. Live, dead and artificial baits are permitted. No limits to the number of lines each boat can fish.
6. Tournament scales open at 12 noon & close at 3 p.m. (Any angler(s) still standing in line at 3:00 p.m. will have their fish weighed and be eligible for awards). Anglers entering fish must return to the weigh station by water, in the boat they fished from. No fish or anglers can be transferred between boats. All fish weighed in must be accompanied to the scale by an angler from the boat it was caught from and be weighed in the presence of the Official Tournament Weigh Master. No mutilated fish will be weighed. Once you weigh in your fishing day is concluded. It is important to keep your fish adequately iced. In the event of a tie (identical weights), the first fish weighed in will win the award based upon time, the other fish will become eligible for the next lowest award category if applicable.
7. Only one (1) fish per category, per boat can be entered in the adult categories. Each junior angler is allowed to weigh in one fish. If a category remains vacant (i.e. no 10th place wahoo entered), that prize will not be awarded.
8. Any award winner receiving \$600 or more will be required to provide a valid taxpayer identification number or Social Security number and will receive an IRS form 1099 at the end of the calendar year; a copy of such will be filed with the IRS. Winners may be subject to a lie detector test at the sole discretion of the Tournament Rules Committee.
9. Junior anglers are not eligible for adult cash awards. Juniors must fight their fish unassisted. Juniors are defined as kids ages 6 - 12 years old (as of June 5, 2021).
10. Any protest concerning a rule violation must be filed with the Tournament Rules Committee by 3:30 pm on the day of the tournament. Protests must be submitted in writing, stating specifics of the protest, and be accompanied by \$500 cash (non-refundable). All decisions made by the Tournament Rules Committee are final and official.

Friday, June 4th

6:00 pm - The tournament Captain's Meeting, will be held in Bicentennial Park at the Riviera Beach Municipal Marina (The marina is located at 200 East 13th Street). At least one crew member from each boat must attend. Tournament boat buckets will be distributed to the first 200 registered boats. Boat numbers will be assigned to every participating vessel. Rules will be reviewed. Food, soda, beer & cocktails will be available onsite. The \$1,000 'Captain's Booty' bonus award, sponsored by Tow Boat U.S., will be randomly drawn. Raffle tickets, additional tournament tees and additional awards dinner tickets will be available for purchase.
