Mike Simko6 Atlantic sailfish releases in Isla Mujeres using 20 Gen tackle
Allison Reiss 1 dolphin (45 lbs.) caught on 30 General tackle at Casa de Campo, DR
John Samuels3 white marlin releases (1 tagged), 1 dolphin & 1 wahoo on 30 Gen tackle in Cap Cana, DR

The Richard Jeck Memorial Billfish Tagging Trophy

Presented annually to the member who tags the most billfish, including swordfish, off Florida & the Bahamas. Anglers must use approved Billfish Foundation or National Marine Fisheries Service tags. Minimum of 20 fish must be tagged to win award.
