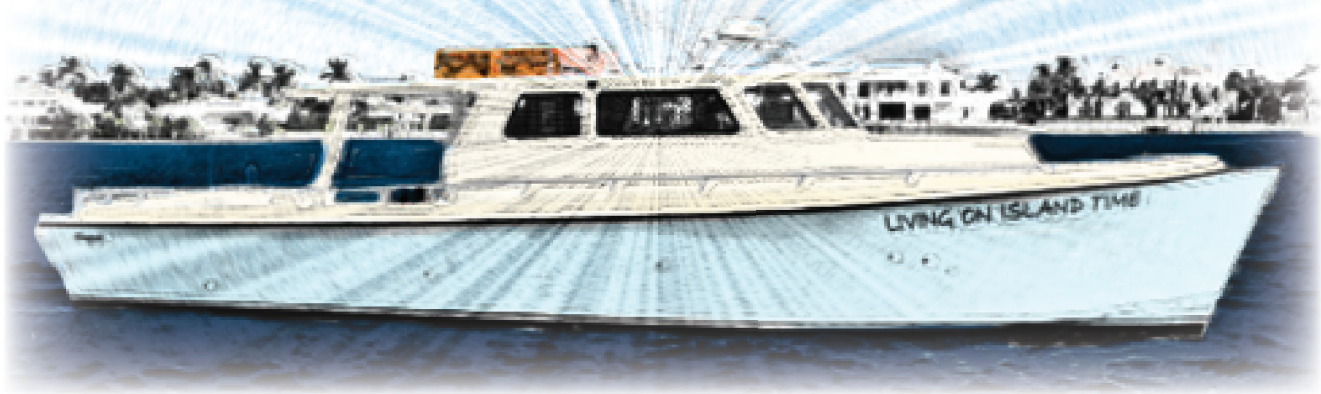


Drift Boat Day

A West Palm Beach Fishing Club half day outing
Friday, February 2, 2024



What: A fun filled half day (morning) drift fishing outing aboard the locally based 'Living On Island Time', berthed at the Palm Beach Yacht Center in Hypoluxo. To ensure a quality experience, this trip is limited to a maximum of 25 anglers. Join us for some camaraderie and competition – confirm your spot today!

Where: Cruising from the Palm Beach Yacht Center, located at 7848 South Federal Hwy., Hypoluxo, Fl. Marina is located between Hypoluxo Rd. & Gateway Blvd. (for more specific directions call (561) 585-4473).

When: Friday, February 2, 2024. 8:00 am – 12 noon (fishing), followed by lunch and awards dockside 'til 1:30 pm. We suggest you arrive 15 minutes before boarding.

Cost: \$60 per person. (limited to 25 anglers. WPBFC members only.) Participation based on first come, first served. Only full payment to the West Palm Beach Fishing Club reserves your spot. No refund on cancellations after Tuesday, January 30th.

****Please Note: It is customary to tip the captain & crew – tip not included in your outing fee.*

Includes: 4 hrs. offshore drift fishing with hourly raffle ticket drawings for a prize package. Fishing followed by lunch/drinks, award presentation & Penn rod raffle drawing at the Yacht Center Tiki Hut. Each participant also receives a WPBFC fish towel.

Prize: \$200 cash for the Heaviest Fish (species NOT eligible include billfish, sharks, 'cudas, bonito). A club certified scale will be used to weigh eligible fish. Fish can be caught, weighed & released. Boat captain or mate will verify all weights. Captain will make any & all final rulings. In the event of a tie, the fish landed first will win the award.

Other: Each angler is limited to fishing 1 rod at a time. Anglers are welcome to bring their own rod (no braided line please) or use the drift boat supplied rod. Rigs & baits will be supplied. Coolers are allowed for snacks & drinks while fishing. Boat captain makes all weather related decisions.
