(qualifying meaning fish meets the minimum weight required for entry). Of those entries, the angler must have a minimum of two (2) winning fish in the Offshore Division and two (2) winning fish in Inshore/Nearshore Division. This must include at least one (1) winning fish in each division in one of the casting categories (Fly, Spin, or Plug). The angler with the most winning fish will be deemed the winner; in the event of a tie, the angler with the most winning fish within the casting categories wins. If this does not break the tie, then the angler's heaviest fish within the casting
> categories will determine the winner.

## Junior Angler of the Year Award

To be eligible for this award, the junior angler (ages 10-18) must submit five (5) different species of fish that are 'qualifying' entries. (qualifying meaning fish meets the minimum weight required for entry). Of those entries, the angler must have a minimum of two (2) winning fish on the board in any division (Offshore and/or Inshore-Nearshore). This must include at least one (1) winning fish in one of the casting categories (Fly, Spin, or Plug). The angler with the most winning fish will be deemed the winner; in the event of a tie, the angler with the most winning fish within the casting categories wins. If this does not break the tie, then the angler's heaviest fish within the casting categories will determine the winner.
