Presented annually to the member scoring the most points for blue marlin releases in Bahamas (100 pts.) and Florida (300 pts.)

Mark Wodlinger..... 32 Pacific sailfish releases & 1 blue marlin release all caught using 25 Gen. tackle in Costa Rica, 2 blue marlin releases in the Bahamas using 30 lb. Gen tackle. 22 striped marlin in Mexico all using 25 lb. Gen tackle.

The Richard Jeck Memorial Billfish Tagging Trophy

Presented annually to the member who tags the most billfish, including swordfish, off Florida & the Bahamas. Anglers must use approved Billfish Foundation or National Marine Fisheries Service tags. Minimum of 20 fish must be tagged to win award.
