

The Nora Award



Presented annually to the member catching the heaviest snook within Florida. (must be weighed on land or suitable stable surface)

Chip DeBay.....26 lb., 12oz.caught & released in Jupiter Inlet using live bait on 10 lb. General tackle. (7/26/25)



The Beinecke Atlantic Blue Marlin Trophy

Presented annually to the member scoring the most points for blue marlin releases in Bahamas (100 pts.) and Florida (300 pts.)

Tonya Love-Cheatham 1,300 pts. (13 releases in the Bahamas)



The Tracy Schneider Memorial Trophy

Presented annually to the member scoring the highest total points for sailfish releases in Florida waters based on the following point values: caught and released on live bait (100 pts.), dead bait (300 pts.), pure artificial lures (500 pts.), and fly (1000 pts.).

Shelby Callison 8200 pts. (76 sail releases on live bait, 2 on dead bait)

The Donald S. Leas III International Angling Trophy

Presented annually to the member who makes the most outstanding catch or catches in international waters (and or including Hawaii & Alaska). Can be fresh or salt water.



Tonya Love-Cheatham.....9 Pacific sailfish releases in Guatemala, 8 Pacific sailfish releases in Costa Rica and 13 blue marlin, 4 white marlin & 3 sailfish releases in the Bahamas, all caught using 30 Gen. tackle. 2 blue marlin releases in Panama on 50 lb. Gen tackle.



The Richard Jeck Memorial Billfish Tagging Trophy

Presented annually to the member who tags the most billfish, including swordfish, off Florida & the Bahamas. Anglers must use approved Billfish Foundation or National Marine Fisheries Service tags. Minimum of 20 fish must be tagged to win award.
