## Tournament Rules & Details

1. Three full moon fishing days: Saturday July 25th, Saturday August 29th, and Saturday September 26th. Entry fee \$60 per moon, or \$150 for all 3 moons (before July 22nd). **Must be a West Palm Beach Fishing Club (WPBFC) member to register. Each team must include one WPBFC member in good standing.**
2. **(Optional) Captain's Meeting:**  
Location and Date: Wednesday, July 22nd, 6pm at the Flotilla Club (4850 N Flagler Drive, WPB, FL 33407)  
Registration available @ captain's meeting, at \$80 per moon, or \$200 for all 3 moons.  
Additional buy-ins also available. Text/call 561-309-1397 for info.  

3. Teams can weigh multiple fish; only (1) wahoo per Full Moon is eligible for their daily/series aggregate total. State & federal recreational fishing rules governing bag limits and licensing must be observed.  

4. Tournament scales open at 10 am - 1 pm & 6 pm - 8:30 pm @ Sailfish Marina on each Full Moon fishing day. Anglers entering fish may return to the weigh station by water in the boat they fished from, or by car/truck.
5. Eastern boundary is 25 nautical miles. Fishing in the Bahamas is prohibited.  
Northern Boundary is Ft. Pierce Inlet: N 27.4744      Southern Boundary is Hillsboro Inlet: N 26.2544.  
Fish must be hooked and landed/boated within the boundary.
6. **All catches must be verified on video with a token of authentication (announced the night before the tournament). It's the team's responsibility to capture footage/evidence of a live/freshly caught wahoo, featuring the required token. To be eligible for the 10-Year Anniversary cash prize, teams must also verify they are fishing within the tournament boundaries by showcasing their location on a navigation unit on-board. Failure to provide video following these guidelines will disqualify a catch. Teams are encouraged to capture the moments the fish is leadered, gaffed, and brought aboard. If a fish "comes up dead" while still on hook and line, teams need to record entire final boating sequence to provide sufficient evidence of the wahoo being landed for the first time within tournament boundary, without any existing holes from being gaffed previously. The Tournament Directors reserve the right, in their sole and absolute discretion, to reject any fish that does not meet the requirements of the Tournament. Any decision of the Tournament Directors to reject a fish is final. Video evidence may be used for tournament promotion and/or social media.**
7. All fish must be caught on rod and reel (**no electric reels for fighting fish**). Kites, downriggers, planers, and wire lines are permitted. No line test restrictions. Live, dead and artificial baits are permitted. No limits to the number of lines each boat can fish. Multiple anglers can fight the same fish. IGFA rules do not apply.
8. No fish or anglers can be transferred between boats. All fish weighed must be accompanied to the scale by an angler from the boat it was caught from. In the event of a tie (identical weights), the fish weighed in first will win the award based upon time. No mutilated fish will be weighed. A fish that's bit is considered mutilated.
9. Teams can use different boats/anglers during the course of the series. WPBFC members can only register one team. A WPBFC member in good standing must be present on the water/vessel while fishing/boating eligible fish.
10. **WEATHER:** The decision to fish is solely the captain's choice. Anglers fish at their own discretion and risk. If the rules committee determines it is unsafe to fish, the tournament may be rescheduled. No entry refunds.
11. Awards will be made payable to the WPBFC member who registers the team (no exceptions). Individuals awarded more than \$2000 will receive an IRS form 1099 ; a copy of such will be filed with the IRS. If a category remains vacant the prize will not be awarded.
12. Rule violation protests must be filed with the Tournament Rules Committee on the day of the tournament. Protests must be submitted in writing & be accompanied by \$300 cash (non-refundable). All decisions made by the Rules Committee are final and official. Anglers may be subject to a lie detector test at the sole discretion of the Tournament Rules Committee.
